

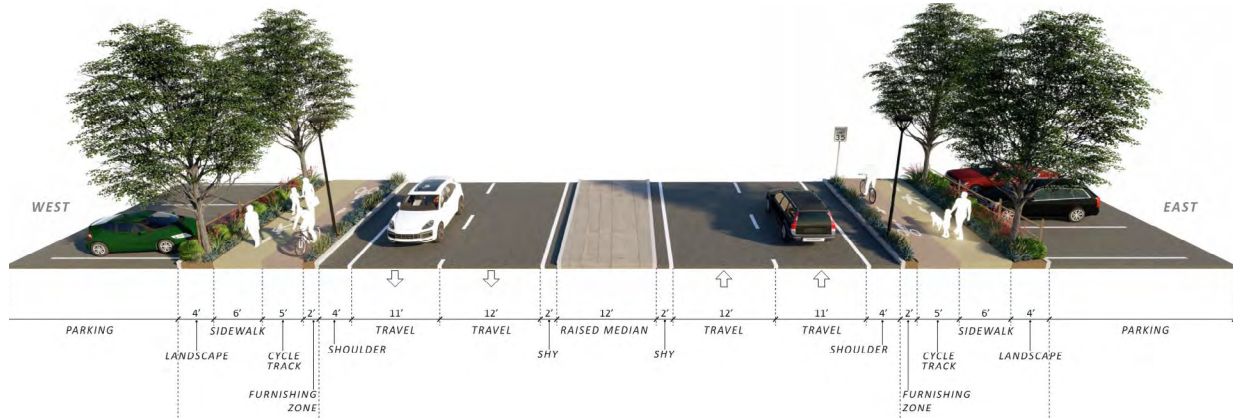
Dear US 97 Businesses and Property Owners,
